KEY DEVELOPMENTS AND INVESTMENT OPPORTUNITIES

Bristol Temple Quarter is one of the UK's leading regeneration and infrastructure development programmes. Over 25 years, 130 hectares will transform into a thriving, well connected mixed-use community delivering 10,000 new homes, 22,000 new jobs, and bringing £1.6bn each year to the city economy. The project will include upgrades to Bristol Temple Meads Station, a new integrated transport hub, and the new **University of Bristol Enterprise Campus**, with a strong focus on innovation and world class R&D facilities for quantum, digital media, and creative.

Bath Quays South is a game-changing development offering 90,000 sqft of riverside contemporary workspace in the heart of Bath. This includes a new creative campus, Newark Works, and a flagship 45,000 sqft grade A office building. **Bath Quays North**, a 2.2 hectares site next to Bath Spa train station, will deliver an incredible 250,000 sqft of modern office space, creating a new central business district for the city.

A new **Hydrogen Hub** will be developed at the University of Bath's **Institute of Advanced Automotive Propulsion Systems (IAAPS)**, a £62m investment in R&D facilities, battery testing and hydrogen manufacturing capability,

right next to the National Composites Centre and in the heart of the UK's largest aerospace cluster with Airbus, Rolls Royce, and GKN Global Technology Centre.

Next door, **Vectura** will be a new £58m world class life sciences HQ, with high performance GMP clean room suite, R&D labs, and over 10,000 sqm of space.

Weston-super-Mare Enterprise Area, part of a £1bn expansion and regeneration programme, includes 72 hectares in the M5 opportunity corridor that will support 10,000 new jobs and 6,000 new homes. £11.3m has already been invested in a new Food Enterprise Zone with a flagship Food & Drink Innovation Centre, **The Food WorksSW**.
